take great care to follow all safety protocols," Jordan said. "The risk of acquiring coronavirus from exposure in these settings is very small. It is a much greater risk to not get a **flu** vaccination.

Both COVID-19 and flu can result in complications, including:

- < Pneumonia
- < Respiratory failure
- Acute respiratory distress syndrome (i.e. fluid in lungs)
- < Sepsis
- Cardiac injury (e.g. heart attacks and stroke)
- Multiple-organ failure (respiratory failure, kidney failure, shock)
- Worsening of chronic medical conditions involving the lungs, heart, nervous system or diabetes
- x < Inflammation of the heart, brain or muscle tissues
 - Secondary bacterial infections (i.e. infections that occur in people who have already been infected with flu or COVID-19)

The CDC recommends that everyone six months of age season, especially people who are considered high risk
