Dr. Elizabeth Trejos is an Assistant Professor in Human Development and Family Studies at Texas Tech University and an Associate Editor of The Journal of Early Adolescence. Her research interests include the influence of family, individual, and contextual factors on health risking behaviors (e.g., delinquency, crime, violence) among ethnic/racial minority and immigrant adolescents using a cross-cultural/cross-national comparative approach.
