## General Health Information: You and Your Work Environment

- 1. The TTUHSC *Health Assessment for Animal Contact Risks OHSP Enrollment Form* is for faculty, staff, students and volunteers who have direct exposure to vertebrate animals and in some cases, animal tissue, body fluids or waste. The OHSP evaluation is based on the type and frequency of exposure to animals.
- 2. The OHSP for personnel with laboratory animal contact administers health risks and medical requirements.
- 3. The following items are recommended:
  - a. Respirator fit testing all individuals in contact with pregnant goats and sheep (provided by Safety Services).
