



Operating Policy and Procedure

SOM OP: 50.18, Licensing Certification (ACLS/DEA/TMHP)

PURPOSE:

- b. Maintenance of Certification. Residents/Fellows who hold a current Texas Medical License are required to maintain a current certificate with the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) throughout the duration of residency training. Failure to provide proof of current certification will result in suspension from clinical duties, and the resident/fellow will be obliged to take vacation time or leave without pay until such documentation is confirmed with the GME office.

3. Texas Medicaid and Health Partnership (TMHP)

- a. Requirement upon Receipt of Licensure. Residents/Fellows who have obtained Texas licensure are required to enroll in Texas Medicaid and Health Partnership (TMHP).

Failure to enroll and notify the GME office within four weeks from the date the medical license was obtained, the resident will be suspended from clinical activities and forced to take vacation time or put on leave without pay.
