

Operating Policy and Procedure

SOM OP: 70.09, Readmissions for Students with Special Circumstances

PURPOSE: The purpose of this School of Medicine (SOM) Policy and Procedure is to describe the

procedures related to a student with special circumstances seeking readmission to medical

school.

REVIEW: This SOM Policy and Procedure shall be reviewed within each fiscal year by the Office of

Admissions. Revisions will be forwarded to the Office of the Dean for approval and

publication.

POLICY/PROCEDURE:

1. **General.** This policy outlines the procedures available to a student(s) with special circumstances who wishes to petition for readmission to the School of Medicine.

2. Definitions. A student must be in "Good Academic Standing" at the time of their withdrawal from the School of Medicine. "Good Academic Standing" includes passing all courses and having no behavioral or professionalism issues required meeting with the Student Promotions and Professional Conduct Committee (SPPCC). See <u>SOM OP 40.09</u>, <u>Student Leave of Absence</u>.
