

# 8 KEYS TO PRINCIPLES OF VETERANSUCCES EXCELLENCE

The "8 Keys to Veterans' Success" are steps that postsecondary institutions can take to assist Veterans and Service members in transitioning to higher education, completing their college programs, and obtaining career reaskills.

The 8 Keys is a volumtainitiative through the Departments of Education, Veterans Affairs, and Defense and highlights specific ways we can support veterans.

Much like the 8 Keys to Veterans' Success, the Principles of Excellen are guidelines for educational institutions receiving Federal funding. Schools that agree to pacipate will:

- End fraudulent and aggressive recruiting techniques and misrepresentation.
- Provide students with a personalized form covering the total cost of an education program.
- Provide educational plans for all Military and Veteran education beneficiaries.
- Provide accommodations for Service Members and Reservists absent due to service requirements.
- Assign a Point of Contact for academic and financials indy
- Make sure all new programs are accredited before they enroll students.
- Align institutional refund policies with those under Title IV.
